

PRICING GUIDE

This is designed to help you calculate an estimate as you think through your floral vision for your wedding. There is a security deposit to cover all rented items, this is typically \$200, but may be increased depending on quantity of rented items. This deposit will be returned following the event if all items are returned in good condition. There will be an additional fee applied depending on services selected, such as drop off of items, or set up and tear down, etc. It is also worth considering that some items, such as aisle runners, can be repurposed to use at the reception as well, which will help you save money even though there is a small relocation/re-set fee.

An official quote will be provided following a floral consult.



Bouquets

Centerpieces are a bit more complex to provide a price estimate. Centerpieces could include bud vases, candles, greenery, books, etc. Centerpieces are a rental only item, in order to keep prices down. A rough estimate would be between \$25-\$50 per table.

Aisle Runners

Aisle runners can range from small to large garden style florals lining the aisle. You could also choose to not have aisle runners and only have florals at the entrance to the aisle. These are also typically rented items. For minimalistic aisle runners, the price will be between \$40-\$60 total. For larger installations, the price range could be between \$100-\$200.

Statement pieces might be used as the backdrop of the ceremony, such as on a cross, or archway. Statement pieces are typically rented and are estimated to cost between \$100-\$300 per statement piece. These prices may vary depending on the scale of the statement piece.

Sweetheart Table

Sweetheart tables are usually smaller tables instead of sitting at a large table with the wedding party. They are designed to draw attention to the bride and groom and often make for a great spot for guests to grab pictures with the newlyweds. Prices typically range from \$40-\$75. These decorations are typically rented, but are available for purchase as well.

As an example of these costs, let's say you are having a wedding with 100 guests (including 10 people in the wedding party). You have 10 tables that seat 10 each, and a sweetheart table. You choose 5 bridesmaids bouquets that come out to \$30 each, plus a bridal bouquet that came out to \$60 (purchased, not rented). You have 6 boutonnieres at \$15 each. You choose a minimalistic aisle runner, at \$50, and repurpose it as the centerpieces. You have a statement piece at the alter that is also repurposed for the sweetheart table with some other adaptations, coming out to \$175.

Before installation fees, and not counting the security deposit, you would be looking at about \$525 for florals.
